

# Bromley Challenge



<b>The Bromley Challenge criteria</b>			
1	A progressive award open to all Scouts, Explorer Scouts, Network Scouts, Scout Active Support members and Leaders.		
2	There is no time limit on the completion of any part of this award.		
3	Camping nights must be spent either in a tent or a bivouac. Nights away spent indoors (e.g. in a campsite building, a youth hostel or your Scout headquarters) do not count.		
4	Where a weekend camp falls over two months (e.g. Fri 30 <sup>th</sup> – Sun 1 <sup>st</sup> ), both months may be counted. For this to apply, individuals must have camped for two nights. A single night falling over two months may only count for one month, the choice for which rests with the individual/leader.		
5	Challenges may only be counted once in total (i.e. they cannot be repeated for a subsequent award).		
6	One night away can only count towards one challenge.		
7	The word 'group' is a general term referring to your Troop / Unit / Scout Group, etc.		
<b>The Bronze Award</b>			
1	Spend four nights camping. Each of these nights must be in a different month.		
2	Complete five of the challenges.		
<b>The Silver Award</b>			
1	Gain the Bronze Award.		
2	Spend a further four nights camping in four different months.		
3	Complete a further seven challenges.		
<b>The Gold Award</b>			
1	Gain the Silver Award.		
2	Spend a further four nights camping in the remaining four months of the year.		
3	Complete a further eight challenges.		
<b>The Challenges</b>			
1	Camp at 1°C or below	21	Take part in a parent and youngster camp
2	Get a good news story about your group in a newspaper	22	Take part in a Group act of worship
3	Camp outside of London and the South-East	23	Sleep out above 600m
4	Camp outside of the UK	24	Take part in a County event
5	Camp on an island other than mainland UK	25	Take part in an activity with another section
6	Take part in a Patrol camp	26	Take part in an overseas expedition
7	Spend a night in a bivouac	27	Complete a 20km (12 mile) hike
8	Camp at a District event	28	Take part in a group fund raising activity
9	Camp as part of an expedition/hike	29	Prepare and cook a meal on an open fire
10	Spend 24 hours with another group of Scouts	30	Cook with no utensils or foil (a knife only)
11	Camp with your Troop/Unit/Group for 7 consecutive nights	31	Camp in Yorkshire
12	Camp at sea level	32	Camp at another District's campsite
13	Camp at least 2m above the ground	33	Spend a night below ground
14	Camp with Scouts from another country	34	Take part in the District 'Moonwalk' comp
15	Attend a St George's Day Parade for 3 consecutive years.	35	Camp in a forest
16	Camp in an unusual place	36	Camp in snow
17	Take part in an activity with another organisation	37	Gain the Outdoor Challenge
18	Wild camp above 500m	38	Gain the Outdoor Plus Challenge
19	Gain a nights away passport/permit and use it	39	Sleep under the stars
20	Gain a Group award	40	Gain the 50 nights away badge
