<b>Transport?</b>	<p><b>Car-sharing is a MUST.</b> Please, please do NOT arrive with just one or two people in the car. Parking space is minimal and this will not help us (or you)</p> <p>When you arrive, you will be directed inside the site to a safe <b>drop-off zone</b>. Your child will be expected to get out and you will be directed out of the site. If you are staying for the <b>whole day</b>, you will be directed where to park (and will not be able to retrieve your vehicle until the end of the day).
